# Baytreat Mission Camp 2022: Come to the Waters - General Information

#### Target Age Group:

 $9^{th} - 12^{th}$  Grade

## Adult Advisors:

The Baytreat Mission Camp Director relies on adult advisors from your congregation to see that youth participate and follow the schedule. Your congregation's adult advisors should expect to fully participate in mission activities and provide leadership and guidance throughout the week. Advisors must be at least 25 years old (*age limit not applicable to church employees*). An adult of each gender must be present for mixed-gender groups, and one adult advisor per every seven campers must be present.

#### Group Size:

Baytreat Mission Camp accommodates group sizes from eight to 28 (including both youth and adult advisors). Please note that groups of 15 people or fewer are accepted with the understanding that we may combine your group with smaller groups from other congregations to assure a rich experience.

## Location & Transportation:

GSPC hosts Baytreat Mission Camp from its historic Baytreat facility on the eastern shore of Mobile Bay – <u>https://www.gspcmobile.org/baytreat</u>. Camp participants will transit daily to the city of Mobile to partner with our mission work sites, and they will return to Baytreat in the early evening. **Congregations must provide their own transportation and fuel. GSPC cannot provide group transportation.** Our mission partners' work sites in Mobile are typically a 45-minute to one-hour drive from Baytreat, depending on the traffic crossing over the Bay. The Baytreat Mission Camp Director will provide detailed directions and ride along with the camp groups each day.

#### **Program Schedule:**

Our 2022 program begins June 4 and operates through July 22. (No camp will be held the week of July 4.) Each camp runs for one week, with campers arriving on Saturday evening and leaving the next Friday morning. Participants begin each day around 6:30 a.m. and go until 10 p.m. This active schedule includes service activities with our mission partners, spiritual reflections in the mornings and evenings, and recreation time. Finally, included in the week's schedule is a half-day visit to Alabama's beaches on the Gulf of Mexico.

<u>Available Dates:</u> June 4 – 10 June 11 – 17 June 18 – 24 June 25 – July 1 July 9 – 15 July 16 – 22

#### Special Needs:

With advance notice, the Baytreat Mission Camp Director will work with your group to accommodate special dietary and physical needs. Baytreat house is ADA compliant. However, there is no ADA accommodation for swimming off Baytreat's pier or gaining access to Baytreat's beach.

# Camp Reservation Deposit:

To reserve a camp week, organizations must provide a Reservation Deposit of \$75 per planned participant up to the first 15 planned participants (i.e., \$600 minimum for a group of eight, then up to a \$1,125 maximum deposit for 15 or more planned participants). **This Reservation Deposit is due by February 15, 2022.** 

We understand that the number of participants may change. No additional Reservation Deposit is necessary after 15 planned participants. Space will be officially reserved upon receipt of the Reservation Deposit. (The Reservation Deposit is refundable only for cancellations made before final payment of Camp Participant Fees. The Reservation Deposit will be applied to the final payment of Camp Participant Fees.)

# Camp Fees:

Participant Fee: \$350 per camper/adult advisor

Participant Fees include six nights lodging at the beautiful, newly renovated Baytreat; sixteen meals (Saturday evening through Friday morning, except for dinner out on Thursday evening); and a Baytreat Mission Camp t-shirt.

## Participant Fees should be paid in full by 4:30 p.m. Central Standard Time on April 1, 2022.

<u>Facility Maintenance Deposit</u>: A \$200 Facility Maintenance Deposit is due with your final Camp Participant Fees payment. Baytreat is a historic structure. The Facility Maintenance Deposit covers added maintenance and the weekly cleaning costs associated with the heavy use by Baytreat Mission Camp. Per the Cancellation Policy, this deposit is only refundable should an organization cancel their camp prior to arrival.

<u>Cancellation Policy for Camp Fee Refunds</u>: A full refund of Camp Fees shall be made if cancellation notice is received IN WRITING (by letter or e-mail) and confirmed by April 1, 2022. No refunds will be made after that date, unless we are able to fill that week with another group.
